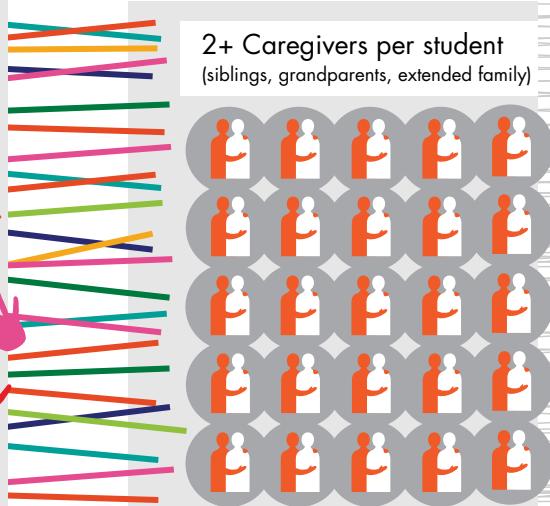

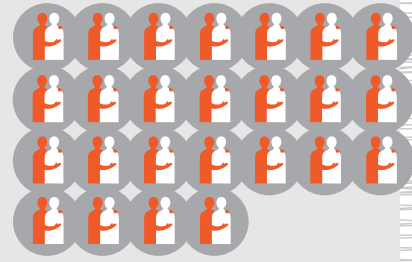
Schools are central to our communities. And they are essential to our safety as well.

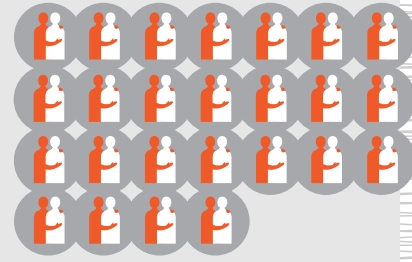
