- 4. Make sure you talk to your recommender prior to emailing them the recommendation form, so they are aware of your scholarship application.
- 5. Submit two recommendation forms (required).

Note: Recommendation forms are no longer a separate document. At the end of the online application, it asks for two recommenders and their email addresses. At that point, the recommendation forms will automatically be emailed to the recommender. Once they complete the form, it will be emailed directly to the scholarship contact, Janeya Dawson.
