

Student CTA Liaison to the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) 2021-22 Application

WHAT IS THE CCTC?

The California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CCTC) is the governing body that conducts regulatory and certification activities for California teachers. The student liaison to the CCTC is an appointed position by the CTA Board of Directors.

MANDATORY MEETINGS

The CCTC usually meets six (6) times per year in Sacramento and dates are as follows. *Tentative Dates

ADDITIONAL MEETINGS

In addition to attending the CCTC meetings, the student liaison also attends the CTA Liaisons Committee (LC) and the Credentials and Professional Development (CPD) Committee. Both committees meet at CTA State Council which convenes four (4) times per year in Los Angeles. **Meetings begin at 11:00 am on Friday.**
